Of particular note was that fact that, for the first time ever, junior students were permitted to participate in contact fighting (as well as the non-contact divisions).

Given that 2016 will see the AKKA celebrate the 40th year of consecutive Nationals, we are planning to show our support by taking a team (of seniors and junior) across the Tasman.

The tournament will be held on the 20th and 21stf August. There will be both Non Contact and Contact fighting and also Kata. As it is the 40^{th} Anniversary of AKKA, Kancho (our Japanese President – 9^{th} Dan) will be attending.

All Students that make the trip will also have an opportunity to participate in Kancho's training seminar.


